POLICY:

Residents/Fellows may not be asked or required to sign a noncompetition guarantee or restrictive covenant as a condition of their participation in a Graduate Medical Education Program.

DEFINITIONS:

<u>Non-Competition/Restrictive Covenant</u>: A provision in a contract that restricts the individual from engaging in a professional activity – usually in a specified geographic area for a specified period of time after completion of employment/training.

PURPOSE:

To ensure that no Christiana Care resident/fellow is required or induced to commit to any non-competition guarantee or restrictive covenant.

SCOPE:

All Christiana Care Residents/Fellows and all Graduate Medical Education Programs at Christiana Care.

PROCEDURE:

Christiana Care and its Graduate Medical Education programs may not require or request a resident or fellow to sign a non-competition guarantee/restrictive covenant. Violations of this policy shall be reported the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
