Online Faculty Development at Thomas Jefferson University

Located on the Pulse Web site of TJU, there are numerous online faculty development modules. Each module takes 20-30 minutes to complete and you can get CME credit. The modules may be completed alone or used in a small group faculty development activity. Simply show the module during a faculty development session and then lead a focused discussion of the module content.

Access instructions: To get your logon information, go to the Jefferson Education Web site <http://www.jefferson.edu/main/education/>

- Select “Pulse” (Pulse is in the upper left corner of the page).
- If you know your logon information, enter your information
- If you do not know your logon information, look on the left side of the page and select “Campus key lookup”
- Enter your last name and the last 4 digits of your Social Security #. Then, select “Campus Key Lookup.” It will give you your campus key. For new users, your initial password is the first initial of your first name, the first initial of your last name and the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number. There also is a “Set/Forgot Campus Key Password” option on that page that you can use if you have forgotten your password. Use that option to reset your password.


Access the Online Faculty Development Modules

- Go to: <http://www.jefferson.edu/jmc/facdev/index.cfm>
- Select the “Self Directed Learning Modules” at top center of the page.
- On the next page, just under the area with “Self Directed Learning Modules” you will now see a link “Access SDL Module List.” Select that link and it will take you to a page with a list of modules. Select the module you wish to take and it will ask you for your campus key. Follow the instructions, filling in needed information, and then take the module.
