DEFINITIONS:

Accrediting Bodies:

The accrediting bodies for graduate medical education at CCHS consist of but not limited to: Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME); American Dental Association (ADA); American Osteopathic Association (AOA); Council on Podiatric Medical Education (CPME); American Society of Hospital-System Pharmacists (ASHP).

PURPOSE:

To define the functions of the Graduate Medical Education Committee [GMEC].

SCOPE:

All graduate medical education programs at CCHS.

PROCEDURE:

The CCHS Medical-Dental Staff Council shall establish the function of the GMEC, in agreement with the Institutional Requirements of the appropriate accrediting body. The GMEC functions will be reviewed with each revision of the accrediting body requirements.
