POLICY:

The Graduate Medical Education Committee will ensure the development of educational conferences on ethical, socioeconomic, and medical/legal issues that affect graduate medical education and on how to apply cost-containment measures in the provision of patient care. Each departmental residency program is to incorporate these topics into regular conference series at which resident attendance is mandatory (for example, Grand Rounds).

To define the necessity for all programs to educate residents in areas of socioeconomic, and medical/legal issues that affect graduate medical education.


SCOPE:
